New Business:

- Accounting: two sides to PTL money (parents and administrative) – pulled out admin side to make it easier to keep track. It is now a separate line item – we will only be able to see the parent's side of the PTL account. Borrowed \$3,000 to send in for matching with Thrivent – add \$5104 back in. Subtract \$2104 for Wasabi and Thrivent match. No magazine totals yet (about \$440). Will made some on Parent's Night Out (made \$905). \$40 for background checks; \$110 for Danielle and \$60 for food. Expenses are volunteer lunch (recess and kitchen aids); fall festival. Total is about \$4500, including \$2500 in reserve.
- Vicki – fundraisers: selling food at the Fall Festival – brought in \$260, spent \$127 – made \$133.88. Little India fundraiser is 4 to 9pm. Owner would like BLS families to bring families to count how many come. Will donate a percentage of sales for the entire night. Mimi's for December. SCRIP is due Wednesday, December 16th. Can use a Mimi's SCRIP card. Box Tops is going – 2 top will get a turkey. So far there about 3000, which is about \$300.
- Rita – Fall Festival wrap-up: turned in expenses to Annette. Total cost without the food was about \$430. Jamba Juice made about \$200, which we will get 20% of. Danna suggests giving the planning position to a paid person on staff at Bethlehem because it requires so much work. Rita was disappointed by the number of people who volunteered to help and is stepping down from running the Fall Festival. About 250 people came, not counting volunteers.
- New PTL members – calls were made to kindergarten and first grade to ask younger student's parents to come to the PTL meetings.
- Carrie – Bobcat Boogie update: sponsorship packet for businesses to look at so that we can get some signed up. BobcatBoogie.org is the race website. Registration starts online in January, which will be the lowest rates. The registration fees will go up the closer it gets to the day of the race.
- New format for meetings – Carrie wants the meetings to go faster. Reports are sent out for people to read before the meeting so that nothing is repeated and only things that need action or discussion are talked about. Try for the next meeting. Instead of sending just an agenda item, send Carrie a report with information pertaining to your subject.
- Parent/Teacher dinner: Chipotle was provided and it was donated. Desserts were donated by parents.
- King Soopers: total for reloadable cards is \$11,000, which means BLS gets about \$600.
- Thank you cards: Rita, Danielle and Karen for the events they each sponsored.
- Karen – Book Fair update: sold about \$5,598.05; Mean Street \$316.66, online 315.11 for a total; 6229.82. \$1300 in Scholastic dollars and \$900 in cash.

- Danielle- Parent's Night Out update: 68 kids showed up, including volunteers. Many parents want to see it happen again. Valentine's Day was suggested. Volunteer parents were only charged \$5 to cover their children's food.
- Teacher report: thanks for the conference dinners and treats. Grandparent's Day is the 18th for Thanksgiving dinner. 260 school lunches for adults are available. Otherwise you have to bring a lunch.
